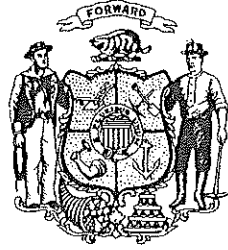

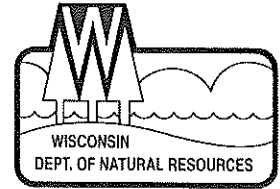

Pursuant to s. 23.0917(6m)(a), (c) and (dr), Wis. Stats., the Department is notifying you as co-chairs of the Committee on Joint Finance of a proposed grant of \$37,880.00 from the Knowles-Nelson Stewardship Program to Polk County for the Lorain acquisition. This is a request for approval to award 2024 fiscal year funds.

The Lorain acquisition is in the Town of Lorain in Polk County. Polk County and the Town of Lorain have issued resolutions in support of this acquisition project.


The entire 40 acres will be enrolled into the County Forest Program and managed consistently with s. 28.11, Wis. Stats., which ensures that the land will be managed for optimum production of forest products together with recreational opportunities, wildlife, and watershed protection.

The property will be open for all nature-based outdoor activities, as defined in s. 23.0916(1)(b), Wis. Stats. The project will connect Polk County Forest and McKenzie Creek State Wildlife Area to provide a large contiguous area of public forest lands while ensuring continued forest management on productive forest lands and increasing recreational opportunities.

As provided in s. 23.0917(6m)(a), Wis. Stats., if the Department does not receive notification of the scheduling of a hearing from either of the Joint Committee on Finance co-chairpersons within 14 working days from submission of this letter, the Department will award this grant.

**SUBJECT:** Request for approval of a Knowles-Nelson Stewardship grant award for land acquisition north of Highway 64.

Pursuant to s. 23.0917(6m)(a), (c) and (dr), Wis. Stats., the Department of Natural Resources is notifying you of a proposed Knowles-Nelson Stewardship grant in the amount of \$37,880.00 to Polk County for acquisition of a 40-acre property known as the Lorain acquisition. The Knowles-Nelson Stewardship program is funded under s. 20.866(2)(ta), Wis. Stats. This is a request for approval to award fiscal year 2024 funds.

Polk County and the Town of Lorain have approved resolutions in support of the acquisition project.

**PROJECT DETAILS:**

**Project Sponsor:** Polk County  
**Grant Sub-Program:** County Forest acquisition  
**Location:** The land is in the Town of Loraine, accessible via County Highway O and existing County Forest

**Project Description:** This 40-acre property connects Polk County Forestry lands and McKenzie Creek State Wildlife Area to provide access to a large contiguous block of public lands. The property is 95% productive and consists of approximately 32 acres of 15-year-old aspen, six acres of mature oak/northern hardwoods and two acres of wetlands. The property has moderate to flat slopes and road infrastructure for future logging and recreation is already established.

This acquisition had been identified by Polk County as a long-term investment for timber production, recreation and watershed protection, accomplishing major goals of the Comprehensive Land Use Plan. This tract will be incorporated into the Stewardship and County Forest programs and managed according to the County's Forest Comprehensive Land Use Plan. Project area maps are attached as Appendix A.

**Project Benefits:** County acquisition of this property will:

- Secure additional blocking to existing County Forest lands for forest management activities and public recreational use.
- Connect two existing blocks of public land to provide contiguous public land ownership and access for recreational activities.
- Ensure connectivity of important recreational trails:
  - Ice Age National Scenic Trail
  - State-funded snowmobile trail
- Add additional productive forest to County holdings, as approximately 95% of the acquisition is productive.
- Support the ongoing partnership with the local Polk County Snowmobile/ATV Council, Ice Age Trail Alliance and the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Forestry, Recreation and Wildlife staff.
- Address several goals and objectives of the current *Polk County Comprehensive Land Use Plan*.
  - Land improves management efficiencies such as reducing the length of private/public boundaries and improving access to existing county forest.
  - Increase the county's inventory of productive timberland and provide a consistent source of raw material to the forest products industry.

- Conserve surface and groundwater, maintain undeveloped shoreline, and increase public access to water features.
- Provide for priority trail connections and expansions or reduce or eliminate existing user conflicts.
- Will not result in unreasonable negative impact to the local tax collections as determined by the Environmental Services Committee.
- Address two primary goals of the current *Polk County Outdoor Recreation Plan*.
  - Investigate and establish recreational trail connections. Maintain and rehabilitate existing recreational trails.
  - Through the coordinated efforts of private and public recreation interests, protect the resources upon which our recreational activities depend in an efficient and cost-feasible manner.
- Provide economic and tax benefit to Polk County and the Town of Lorain by having lands enrolled in the County Forest Law, in comparison to current ownership which is a non-profit organization and therefore, not a tax base.
  - Town of Lorain will have a net increase of approximately \$114/year by having the lands enrolled in County Forest Law.

Polk County and Town of Lorain have issued resolutions in support of this acquisition project. The resolutions are attached as Appendix B.

**Public Uses:** The parcel will be open to the public year-round for hunting, fishing, trapping, hiking, cross-country skiing, snowshoeing, biking, horseback riding and motorized recreation. The Department’s analysis of the permitted nature-based outdoor activities is attached as Appendix C.

**Property Management:** The property will be enrolled into the County Forest Program and managed consistently with s. 28.11, Wis. Stats., which ensures that the land will be managed for forest products production, recreational opportunities, wildlife, and watershed protection. Management will occur according to the *Polk County Forest Comprehensive Land Use Plan*, as approved by the Department.


