



Dear Senator Marklein and Representative Born:

Pursuant to s. 23.0917(6m), Wis. Stats., the Department is notifying you as co-chairs of the Committee on Joint Finance of a proposed acquisition grant of \$394,280 from the Knowles-Nelson Stewardship Program to The Prairie Enthusiasts for land acquisition.

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The acquisition is located in the Town of Blue Mounds, Dane County. The proposed project will provide popular outdoor recreation options in the southcentral part of the state, while protecting 77.1 acres of critical habitat for prairie and grassland endangered and threatened species, the headwaters of two trout streams, and the quality and supply of groundwater at one of the highest groundwater recharge areas in Dane County. The property will be open to nature-based outdoor activities, as defined in s. 23.0916(1)(b), Wis. Stats.

As provided in s. 23.0917(6m)(a), Wis. Stats., if the Department does not receive notification of the scheduling of a hearing from either of the Joint Committee on Finance co-chairpersons within 14 working days from submission of this letter, the Department will award this grant.

SUBJECT: Request for approval of a Stewardship grant exceeding \$250,000

Pursuant to s. 23.0917(6m), Wis. Stats., the Department of Natural Resources is notifying you of a proposed Knowles-Nelson Stewardship grant of \$394,280 to The Prairie Enthusiasts for the acquisition of 77.1 acres in Dane County. The Knowles-Nelson Stewardship program is funded under s. 20.866(2)(ta), Wis. Stats.

I. PROJECT DETAILS:

Project Sponsor: The Prairie Enthusiasts

Grant Sub-Program: Habitat Areas

Location: The subject property is located in the Town of Blue Mounds, Dane County. Project maps are attached as Appendix A.

Project Description: The property has slightly rolling topography, with 70ft. of elevation change, and no improvements on-site. The property is located between Mt. Horeb and Blue Mounds, with access to the parcel by access easement off Hwy E to the east of the parcel.

Key Benefits: The property will provide outdoor recreation for hiking, hunting, trout fishing and bird watching, expanding on the same popular outdoor recreation opportunities offered by TPE's adjacent Erbe Grassland property. Acquisition and restoration will protect a parcel with one of the highest groundwater recharge rates in Dane County, maintaining and increasing groundwater quality and quantity. The property also contains the headwaters of two Class II trout streams, German Valley Branch and Gordan Creek. The project will protect and restore original prairie vegetation, as well as critical habitat for 14 threatened, endangered or special concern prairie/grassland dependent species. The Prairie Enthusiasts have a long-term agreement on the adjacent 60 acres immediately west of the subject parcel for grassland management.

- Dane County Conservation Fund

- Bobolink Foundation, will fund long-term management and endowment
- Southwest Grasslands and Stream Conservation Area

Project Goals: The Uren Trust acquisition will advance several conservation and recreation objectives:

- Supports grassland acquisition and restoration in the Military Ridge Prairie Heritage Area.
- Supports the goals of the Department's Southwest Wisconsin Grassland & Stream Conservation Area feasibility study.
- Directly addresses multiple Ecological Opportunities identified in the Department's Southwest Savanna Regional Master Plan:



- o Large-scale Grassland Management
- Native Prairie Remnants
- Directly address multiple goals and objectives identified in Dane County's Land and Water Resource Management Plan:
 - O Assess, protect and improve surface water and groundwater resources
 - o Reduce the quantity of sediment and nutrients reaching surface waters and groundwater
 - o Improve soil health to reduce erosion, improve infiltration and reduce nutrient loses
 - Protect groundwater resources

Public Uses: The property will be open to nature-based outdoor activities as defined in s. 23.0916(1)(b), Wis. Stats.

Property Management: The property will be managed by The Prairie Enthusiasts as part of Erbe Grasslands according to a Land Management Plan approved by the Department.

Timetable: Pending grant approval, The Prairie Enthusiasts will close on this property no later than March 31, 2025.




