Dear Senator Darling and Representative Nygren:

Section 25.17 (17), Wis. Stats., directs SWIB to provide an annual report regarding credits ("soft dollars") it generates with securities brokerage firms and describe how those credits are used to acquire investment research services. SWIB generated no soft dollar credits in 2016. All credits that had accumulated in previous years were fully expended in 2006.

Soft dollars are credits earned from trading with certain brokers. Soft dollar credits can be used to purchase investment research services. Federal law and Securities and Exchange Commission regulations define allowable uses of soft dollars.
