TECHNICAL EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM
Annual Status Report
October 15, 2018

Seventy-seven percent of the freshmen awarded the Technical Excellence Scholarship (TES) in 2017 accepted the scholarship and used it to attend a Wisconsin Technical College. The Technical Excellence Scholarship was available for the first time during the 2015-2016 academic year with 348 Wisconsin high schools participating.

In 2017-2018, 520 freshmen enrolled in a Wisconsin Technical college. Total TES funds going to these students was \$522,439 with an average per freshman award of \$995.

Three tables are attached, showing final figures for 2017-2018, along with preliminary data for 2018-2019.

- Tables I presents enrollment by individual Wisconsin Technical College. These figures represent the students who received TES program funds.
- Table II presents General Scholar Data for the first three years of the Technical Excellence Scholarship.
- Table III gives preliminary information for 2018-2019 freshmen.
