SUBJECT: General School Aid and Property Tax Credit Provisions of Governor's Budget Bill

This memorandum provides information on the provisions in the Governor's 2019-21 biennial budget bill (Senate Bill 59/Assembly Bill 56) that would provide additional general school aid funding, modify the general school aid formula, and eliminate the school levy tax credit and the first dollar tax credits.

Background

General School Aids. The general school aids appropriation funds equalization, integration (Chapter 220), and special adjustment aids. In 2018-19, \$4,656.8 million from the general fund is appropriated for general school aids. Of the total amount of funding provided, 401 of the 422 school districts in the 2018-19 aid distribution are eligible for \$4,594.6 million in equalization aid, 25 districts are eligible for \$50.4 million in integration aid, and 62 districts are eligible for \$11.8 million in special adjustment aid.

A major objective of the equalization aid formula is tax base equalization. The formula operates under the principle of equal tax rate for equal per pupil expenditures. In pure form, this means that a school district's property tax rate does not depend on the property tax base of the district, but rather on the level of expenditures. The provision of state aid through the formula allows a district to support a given level of per pupil expenditures with a similar local property tax rate as other districts with the same level of per pupil expenditures, regardless of property tax wealth. There is an inverse relationship between equalization aid and property valuations. Districts with low per pupil property valuations receive a larger share of their costs through the formula than districts with high per pupil property valuations.

The equalization aid formula is calculated using school district data (pupil membership, shared costs, and equalized valuations) from the prior school year. There are three guaranteed valuations

used in the equalization formula that are applied to three different expenditure levels. The rate at which shared costs are aided through the formula is determined by comparing a district's per pupil property value to the three guaranteed valuations. Equalization aid is provided to make up the difference between the district's actual tax base and the state's guaranteed tax base.

The first tier is for shared costs up to the primary cost ceiling of \$1,000 per member. State aid on these primary shared costs is calculated using the primary guaranteed valuation of \$1,930,000 per member. Both the primary cost ceiling and the primary guarantee are set in statute. Primary aid is based on a comparison of the school district's equalized valuation per member to the \$1,930,000 guarantee. Primary aid equals the amount of costs that would be funded by the missing portion of the guaranteed tax base. Every district whose equalized valuation per member is below \$1,930,000 receives at least the primary aid amount. Primary aid cannot be reduced by negative aid generated at the secondary or tertiary aid levels. This feature of the formula is referred to as the primary aid hold harmless.

The second tier is for shared costs that exceed \$1,000 per member but are less than the secondary cost ceiling, which is equal to \$9,729 per member in aid year 2018-19. By law, the secondary cost ceiling is set equal to 90% of the prior year statewide shared cost per member. The state's sharing of secondary costs is calculated using the secondary guaranteed valuation. By law, the secondary guarantee is set at the amount that generates equalization aid entitlements that are equal to the total amount of funding available for distribution. In aid year 2018-19, the secondary guaranteed valuation is \$1,241,233.

The third tier is for shared costs that exceed the secondary cost ceiling of \$9,729 per member in aid year 2018-19. State aid on tertiary shared costs is calculated using the tertiary guarantee, which is, by law, set at the statewide average equalized valuation per member. The tertiary guarantee is \$594,939 in aid year 2018-19. If a school district's tertiary aid is a negative number, this amount is deducted from its secondary aid. As noted above, if the sum of a district's secondary and tertiary aid is a negative number, this amount is not deducted from its primary aid amount.

Equalization aid is distributed to districts according to the following statutory payment schedule: 15% on the third Monday in September; 25% on the first Monday in December; 25% on the fourth Monday in March; and 35% on the third Monday in June. A district may also request to receive payments equal to 10% of its total aid entitlement each month from September to June, at the cost of compensating interest payments to the state. The state pays \$75 million of equalization aid on a delayed basis, with districts receiving these monies on the fourth Monday in July of the following school year.

Special adjustment aid is fully funded as a first draw from the general school aids appropriation. The state provides additional general aid to districts as a hold harmless to limit any year-to-year decline in a district's general aid payment. An eligible district receives a payment equal to the amount needed to make the district's total general aid eligibility equal to 85% of its prior year's general aid payment.

School Levy Tax Credit. The school levy tax credit is extended to all taxable property. For the

2018(19) property tax year, \$940.0 million is provided for the levy credit. The credit is distributed based on each municipality's share of statewide levies for school purposes during the preceding three years multiplied by the annual amount appropriated for the credit and allocated proportionately to reduce individual owners' property tax bills. Although the credit is based on school levies, the credit is initially paid to municipalities or counties. The state pays the credit on the fourth Monday in July. Since the levy reduction under the school levy tax credit (excluding the effects of using a three year levy average) is proportionate for all districts and produces a similar reduction in tax rates, the credit could be characterized as neutral with regard to equalization. Statewide, the credit reduced the school portion of 2018(19) property tax bills by an average of 19%.

The school levy tax credit was considered, by statute, as part of state support of K-12 public schools from 1996-97 through 2002-03 when the state provided two-thirds funding of partial school revenues. The reason for this statutory treatment of the school levy tax credit was that the credit, like general school aids, serves to reduce the burden on property taxpayers of funding public schools. General school aids are paid directly to school districts and, under revenue limits, reduce the school property tax levy dollar-for-dollar. The school levy tax credit is paid to counties or municipalities and is shared with all levying units through the tax settlement process. As shown by the annual comparative revenue data compiled by DPI, school districts receive the full amount of the gross school property tax levy each year. Most of this revenue is generated by property taxes, but a portion of this money comes from the school levy tax credit. In effect, the state acts as a property taxpayer through the school levy tax credit.

The point that general school aids and the school levy tax credit have a similar effect on school districts and taxpayers can be illustrated by considering a modification to current law. Under this option, the school levy tax credit would be paid out using the same distribution formula as under current law, but would be sent directly to school districts and treated as general school aids for revenue limit purposes. Under this option, school districts would receive the credit directly from the state in the form of general school aids. Their gross levy would be reduced, but their net levy would be unchanged. Because the distributional formula would be unchanged, they would receive the same amount of revenue as under current law, with the credit being paid directly to the district, rather than being received by the district through the tax settlement process. Such a shift in approach from using a tax credit to, instead, directly paying general aid would not provide school districts with any more, or less, money to support their classrooms than under current law.

First Dollar Credit. The first dollar credit, which was created in the 2007-09 biennial budget act, is funded from the same appropriation as the school levy tax credit. For the 2018(19) property tax year, \$150.0 million is provided for the first dollar credit. The first dollar credit is extended to each taxable parcel of real estate on which improvements are located. The credit is calculated for each eligible parcel of property by multiplying the property's gross school tax rate by a credit base value determined by the Department of Revenue (DOR) or the property's fair market value, whichever is less. For 2018(19), DOR set the value base at \$7,000. School taxes eligible for the credit are limited to taxes levied for K-12 education. Similar to the levy credit, funding is distributed to counties or municipalities to be applied as a credit to property tax bills after school districts have set their levies. For 2018(19), an estimated credit of \$66 was extended to all improved properties with values over \$7,000 that are located in a school district with a tax rate at the statewide average

of 9.44 mills ($\$7,000 \times 0.00944 = \66). DOR does not collect data on the number of taxable improved parcels by school district, and school district and municipal boundaries are generally not contiguous. As a result, estimated credit amounts cannot credibly be allocated by school district on a statewide basis.

High Poverty Aid. Under the 2007-09 biennial budget act, an appropriation was created to provide additional unrestricted aid to school districts with high poverty. In 2018-19, \$16.8 million from the general fund is appropriated for high poverty aid, with 68 districts eligible for aid.

A district is eligible for aid if at least 50% (rounded to the nearest whole percentage point) of the district's enrollment on the third Friday in September in the immediately preceding even-numbered year satisfied the income eligibility criteria for a free or reduced-price lunch in the national school lunch program. Aid per pupil is calculated by dividing the amount of funding appropriated by the total membership in all eligible districts, based on the equalization aid membership used in the calculation in the first year of the biennium. A district's total payment is determined by multiplying that amount by each district's membership.

For all school districts except the Milwaukee Public Schools (MPS), this aid is subject to revenue limits. For MPS, the school property tax levied for the purpose of offsetting the aid reduction attributable to the Milwaukee private school choice program is reduced by the amount of this aid received by MPS. In either case, the effect of this aid reduces the school property tax levy of the eligible school district. Because high poverty aid has the effect of reducing the amount of property taxes levied by the school districts that receive this aid, it is considered a form of general aid.

Summary of Bill Provisions

The bill would make several modifications to funding levels for general school aids and property tax credits and to the state's general aid formula, as described below.

School Levy and First Dollar Tax Credits. Beginning in 2020-21, the bill would eliminate the school levy tax credit (\$940.0 million) and the first dollar tax credit (\$150 million) and, instead, distribute the same amount of funding (\$1,090.0 million) through general school aids. Similar to the current tax credits, this general school aid would be paid in July after the end of each school year under the bill. Under a separate provision of the bill, \$75 million would be provided in 2019-20 to buy back the current law payment delay under which the state pays that amount of aid on a delayed basis in July of the following school year. As a result, the \$1,090.0 million would be the ongoing delayed general aid payment under the bill.

Because revenue limits would continue to apply to the sum of general school aids and school property taxes, the proposed shift in funding from the tax credits to general school aids would reduce the statewide gross school property tax levy by \$1,090.0 million. However, there would be no effect on the statewide net school property tax levy that is actually paid by taxpayers, since the tax credits that currently buy down the gross school property tax levy by \$1,090.0 million would be repealed. Although there would be no effect on net property taxes on a statewide basis, net property taxes would vary district by district under the bill.

As noted earlier, estimated first dollar credit amounts cannot credibly be allocated by school district on a statewide basis. As a result, while the bill shifts funding for the first dollar credit, DPI has excluded the first dollar credit in the distributional information it released on similar school finance proposals in recent years. This office also excludes the first dollar credit from the distributional information presented in this memorandum.

High Poverty Aid. The bill would eliminate high poverty aid, beginning in 2020-21. Base funding of \$16.8 million would be reallocated to the general school aids appropriation. Because general school aids and high poverty aid are both received by school districts and are subject to revenue limits, there would be no statewide gross or net levy change as a result of this provision, although the distribution of this aid among school districts would differ.

General Aid Base Funding Increase. In addition to the shifts in funding described above, the bill would also provide an additional \$205.0 million in 2019-20 and \$406.3 million in 2020-21 over base level funding of \$4,656.8 million in 2018-19 for general aid.

The bill would also restore the state's two-thirds funding commitment, beginning in the 2020-21 school year. The administration estimates that, under all of the school finance provisions of the bill, state support would be 68.6% in 2020-21.

Low-Income Pupil Weighting. Under current law, each full-time pupil in grades 1 through 12 is counted as 1.0 pupil in membership. Five-year-old kindergarten students are counted on a full-time equivalency basis, and four-year-old kindergarten students are counted as 0.5 or 0.6 pupil, depending upon the amount of outreach programming provided. Under the bill, each pupil eligible for federal free- or reduced-price lunch would be weighted by an additional 20% (be counted as 1.2 pupil rather than 1.0 pupil) for purposes of the membership count used in calculating equalized value per member under the general school aids formula.

Using an additional 20% weight for low-income pupils when calculating equalized value per member would cause the equalized value per member calculation for districts with such pupils to be lower than under current law. Because each district's equalized value per member is compared to the guarantees under the formula, with the formula supplying aid to fund the portion of guaranteed tax base that the district is missing, a district that under the bill would have a lower value per member would generally receive more aid than otherwise.

This provision would have the effect of providing more aid to school districts with low-income pupils. However, as noted above, because revenue limits would continue to apply to the sum of general school aids and school property taxes, the proposed low-income pupil weighting would not provide additional resources to school districts. If a district receives more aid because of this provision, under revenue limits the additional aid would reduce its school property tax levy, leaving it with the same amount of overall revenue to support its operations. For such a district, the mix of revenues would shift so that the district would receive more in state aid and less in property taxes, but the district would not receive any additional money to spend.

It is important to note that this provision would not automatically result in a district receiving

20% more in aid for each low-income pupil. Rather, this provision would modify how one factor in the formula (property value per pupil) is calculated, which would affect the entire distribution of aid.

Minimum Aid. The bill would specify that every school district would receive at least \$3,000 per member of general school aids. Under current law, the formula does not include any provision relating to minimum aid, so that a school district with equalized value per member in excess of the primary guarantee (\$1,930,000 per member) will not receive equalization aid, although it may qualify for special adjustment aid.

However, under current law, property taxpayers in every school district benefit from the school levy tax credit and the first dollar tax credit. These credits would be eliminated under the bill, and the minimum aid provision might be viewed as providing aid to every district to offset the loss of the tax credits.

Secondary Cost Ceiling. Under the bill, the secondary cost ceiling would be set at 100% of the prior year statewide shared cost per member, rather than 90% as under current law. Had the bill applied in 2018-19, the secondary cost ceiling would have been \$10,810, rather than \$9,729 as under current law. Under the bill, more costs would have been aided at the secondary level with its more generous guarantee, so that the lower level of state aid under the tertiary guarantee would only apply to school districts for shared costs that exceed the statewide average.

Special Adjustment Aid. Under the bill, special adjustment aid would be calculated based on 90% of a district's prior year general aid payment, rather than 85% under current law. This provision would further limit year-to-year declines in a district's general aid payment.

Hold Harmless Funding. A new appropriation for hold harmless aid would be created under the bill. For eligible districts, aid would be paid in the amount needed to provide the district with the same amount of funding from the sum of general aid, the school levy credit, and high poverty aid under the bill in 2020-21 as they would have received from those three sources under current law. The bill would provide \$7.5 million in hold harmless aid. Under the bill, no hold harmless aid could be paid after the 2020-21 school year.

Other School Finance Provisions. While not considered in this memorandum, the bill would make other changes related to K-12 school finance. These include: (a) setting the per pupil adjustment under revenue limits at \$200 in 2019-20 and \$204 in 2020-21 and indexing it to inflation each year thereafter; (b) increasing the low revenue adjustment under revenue limits from \$9,400 per pupil in 2018-19 to \$9,700 in 2019-20 and \$10,000 in 2020-21; (c) increasing funding for certain current law categorical aid appropriations, including special education, school mental health programs, and bilingual-bicultural aid; (d) creating new categorical appropriations for certain purposes, including after-school programs, early childhood education, and driver education; and (e) counting full-day four-year-old kindergarten pupils as 1.0 pupil rather than 0.5 or 0.6 under current law.

Distributional Information

Attachment 1 provides distributional data for the bill provisions related to modifications to the general aid formula, the reallocation of the school levy tax credit, and the additional \$406.3 million in general aid funding and \$7.4 million in hold harmless aid funding provided in the second year of the biennium. Attachment 1 shows the general aid and high poverty aid received by each school district in 2018-19 under current law and the estimated school levy tax credit allocation by district, based on the equalized value of the portions of the underlying municipalities located within each district's boundaries, as well as the total state support funding for each district. Also shown is the estimated general aid, hold harmless aid, and total aid that would have been received by each district in 2018-19 had the bill provisions been effective for that year, as well as the change in state support funding under the bill compared to current law, both in dollar and percentage terms. The approach used in Attachment 1 is the same as that used by DPI in past agency budget requests and is consistent with distributional information on the bill published by DPI in February.

The other three attachments to this memorandum provide additional distributional information related to aspects of the bill. Attachment 2 provides information on the distributional impact of the bill provisions, using the most recent data, if no additional general aid funding was provided. Including the additional funding in the distribution, while an accurate representation of the bill provisions, tends to mask the effect of the formula changes and funding shifts that are also included in the bill.

Attachment 2 shows the sum of general aid and high poverty aid received by each district and the estimated school levy tax credit received by the underlying municipalities in each district under current law for 2018-19. Attachment 2 also shows the distribution of funding for each district under two scenarios. The first scenario presents estimates as if the aid and credit provisions of the bill had been implemented in 2018-19 with the exception of the general aid base funding increase and the hold harmless payments. Under this scenario, no additional funding would be appropriated, but the school levy tax credit and high poverty aid funding would be shifted to general aid. The changes to the general aid formula (low-income pupil weighting, minimum aid, special adjustment aid, and the secondary cost ceiling) would also be included. Attachment 2 shows the total payment each district would receive under that scenario, and the change in the total payment under this scenario as compared to current law, both in dollar and percentage terms.

Under this scenario, 231 districts would receive more aid compared to current law, while 190 districts would receive less aid. A total of \$73.7 million (1.3% of available funding) would be reallocated between districts statewide.

Also shown in Attachment 2 is the distribution of funding under a second scenario. The second scenario presents estimates as if the bill provision for hold harmless aid were included in the first scenario described above. Under this second scenario, no base funding increase for general aid would be provided, but the state would provide additional funding to ensure that no district would lose funding as a result of the other aspects of the bill. Under this second scenario, the same 231 districts would receive additional funding in the same amounts as under the first scenario, but the state would have to provide \$73.7 million in hold harmless funding to ensure that the other 190 districts would

not lose funding compared to current law.

If the state is able to provide additional K-12 funding in the upcoming biennium, there are different mechanisms through which it can be distributed. Attachment 3 shows the breakdown of state support funding for each district under the bill had it applied in 2018-19 (as also shown in Attachment 1) compared to the breakdown for an option where \$413.7 million in additional funding (the sum of the \$406.3 million base funding increase for general aid and the \$7.4 million in hold harmless funding estimated under the bill) were instead appropriated through the current law general aid formula in 2018-19. A total of 227 districts would have received more state support funding under the provisions of the bill, while 190 would have received more funding under the current law formula. State support to four districts would have been equal under both options.

Attachment 4 shows a similar breakdown comparing the state support funding for each district under the bill had it applied in 2018-19 with an option where the \$413.7 million were instead appropriated for the school levy tax credit in 2018-19. A total of 213 districts would have received more state support funding under the provisions of the bill, while 208 would have received more funding through the school levy tax credit formula.

When comparing the three options shown in Attachments 3 and 4, 190 districts would have received the greatest increase under the bill provisions, had they been in effect for 2018-19. A total of 122 districts would have received the greatest increase if the funding were distributed through the current law general aid formula, while 109 districts would have received the greatest percentage increase if the funding were distributed through the school levy tax credit formula.
