As required under Section 301.03 (6r) of the Wisconsin State Statutes, I am submitting information relative to the number of Persons in our Care (PIOC) that the Department of Corrections (DOC) considers violent and the total number of PIOCs.

The DOC defines "Violent PIOCs" in accordance with Section 301.048(bm) and with standards set by the Correctional Leaders Association. This definition is based upon conviction of certain crimes, not current behavior within the DOC institutions.

Total number of PIOCs is defined as adult PIOCs assigned to a Type "1" prison in state and in contract facilities. This does not include offenders under supervision of the Division of Community Corrections (DCC) held in a Division of Adult Institution (DAI) facility as an Alternative to Revocation (ATR) or pending revocation. It also excludes PIOCs pending

revocation, pending admission, county holds, PIOCs serving another state's sentence who are in a Wisconsin DOC facility, and PIOCs currently in escape status.
