SECTION III: ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE OF CHARTER SCHOOLS

Advanced Learning Program (ALPs)

ALPs Goals and Supporting Data

Goal: ALPs teaching staff will maintain quality educator status by attending local, state, and national conferences related to gifted education, at-risk populations, and charter school reform.

ALPs teaching staff have maintained quality educator status and have attended a number of virtual conferences and have taken advantage of other professional development opportunities offered in the state. COVID-19 has impacted the ability to attend conferences and professional developments. ALPs teachers have also been trained in CPM and Bridges math curriculum, and attended district-sponsored literacy and science training. This past year collaboration focused on equity and inclusion practices.

Goal: 100% of the students completing state-designated assessments will perform at proficient or advanced levels.

Due to COVID-19 Students did not complete the Wisconsin Forward Exam in 2020. However, students did complete the Forward Exam in Spring of 2021. These results will be released in late summer.

Goal: 80% of students will demonstrate a year or more of academic growth over the course of an academic school year.

ALPs Charter School assessed students in literacy and math at the beginning and end of the 2020-2021 school year using iReady. 96% of students demonstrated a year or more growth in Literacy and 96% of students demonstrated a year or more growth in Math on the iReady assessments..

Goal: 100% of the ALPs Students will incorporate technology into their learning.

All ALPs students utilized Chrome books and technology as part of their learning on a daily basis.

Goal: Students will progress toward being "college, career, and global community ready" as evidenced by 85% of students performing at proficient or advanced levels on Life and Career Skills Assessments

90% of ALPs students performed at the proficient or advanced level on Life and Career Skills during the 2020-2021 school year. COVID-19 and At-Home Learning impacted this data point.

Goal: 85% of parents and students will express satisfaction or high satisfaction with the ALPs school education and social/emotional programming.

A survey of ALPs families revealed that 100% of parents were overall satisfied or highly satisfied with the ALPs program. The survey also revealed that 100% of parents were satisfied or highly satisfied with the social emotional programming of the ALPs Charter School.

Goal: Parents and community members will be involved in the daily educational and social programs as well as the design, management, and operations of the school.

ALPs maintains a Governance Council that meets quarterly and serves to guide the Charter School. COVID-19 did impact the group's ability to meet as frequently as the previous year. The Governance Council has been instrumental in developing a mission and vision for the school since moving to the Tipler building, which is reflected in the contract agreement itself. In addition, the Governance Council has had input in the entrance and dismissal criteria for students entering or exiting the ALPs program. The staff at ALPs is consistently looking for ways to have students participate in community events such as fundraisers to help community causes. At the same time, community members are invited to participate and enhance classroom learning objectives.

ALPs Accomplishments

ALPs students and staff participated in a successful year of learning using many different learning models including hybrid, virtual, and face to face.

In May, ALPs students presented a drive-thru presentation for families that focused on different regions of the United States and different United States Presidents.

The number of applications to attend ALPs Charter School continues to outnumber the available seats (60). There were a total of 22 official applications from families to attend ALPs during the 2019-20 school year. The 22 applicants competed for a total of 18 open seats (9 for 4th grade, 4 for 6th grade). A lottery process was used (per the

contract agreement) to select the students that met entrance criteria and would be joining the program.

Shapiro STEM Academy

Goals and Supporting Data

During the 2020-21 school year, many of our staff development and program plans needed to shift to focus on transforming teaching and learning to meet the ever-changing learning models. Much of our professional development centered around technology which was critical to enable educators to reach our entire student population while in the different learning models. In addition, we needed to address the numerous safety protocols in place during in-person instructional models. Therefore, all action steps of our program plan were not able to be carried out to fidelity in the 2020-2021 school year.

Due to the pandemic and changing models, families were not able to come into our school for face-to-face connection opportunities. However, virtual learning provided us the opportunity to work with families daily. Teachers were able to see the needs of our learners and meet the needs of our learners and families physically (access to wifi, food, supplies) emotionally and academically. Strong relationships were built due to the nature of being in our students' homes virtually. Teachers met with students and families beyond the traditional hours of brick-and-mortar school to meet the varying needs of our families. In addition, siblings, grandparents, caregivers joined morning meetings and learning and watched the learning unfold which provided multiple opportunities for modeling. Videos were also provided for families that could not attend "Live" learning sessions.

As a building, we collect student data focused on formal and informal assessments to support the next steps of instruction and growth measurement. Teachers reflected on pre-assessment data, progress monitoring data (on demands throughout the school year), and post-assessment data. Multiple collaborative opportunities supported data analysis to inform instructional decisions for one-on-one, small and whole group instruction.

Measurable Objective/Outcome #1: 100% of Shapiro STEM Academy teaching staff maintain high quality educator status in regards to the Department of Public Instruction for the state of Wisconsin. OASD Board Policy - Employment of Professional Staff - po3120 Professional staff engaged throughout the year in grade level, school, district and state level professional development opportunities to enhance their craft to support student achievement.

Measurable Objective/Outcome #2: Due to the pandemic and virtual learning models at different times throughout the year, not all students were able to be assessed after multiple teacher attempts. Of the students that were assessed during the district indicated assessment window, 100% of assessed students demonstrated growth in writing proficiency as evidenced by writing rubrics specific grade level standards recorded in Infinite Campus.

Measurable Objective/Outcome #3: Due to the pandemic and virtual learning models at different times throughout the year, not all students were able to be assessed after multiple teacher attempts. Of the students that were assessed during assessment windows 100% of assessed students demonstrated growth in reading proficiency as evidenced by the Developmental Reading Assessment. Note: Growth is defined in text level and/or comprehension level.

Measurable Objective/Outcome #4: Due to the pandemic and virtual learning models at various times not all students were able to be assessed after multiple teacher attempts. Of the students that were assessed during assessment windows 100% of assessed students demonstrated growth in mathematical proficiency as evidenced by one or more areas from the Advantage Math Recovery Assessments (AVMR).

Measurable Objective/Outcome #5: Instructional minutes in Science and Engineering averaged 200 minutes or more per week for Shapiro STEM Academy as evidenced by teacher schedules and observed instructional times with a problem/project-based learning environment. <u>Teacher Schedule Link</u>

Measurable Objective/Outcome #6: Note: In elementary school, the College, Career, and Community Readiness is measured by our Elementary Life and Career Skills and attendance rate. The Life and Career Skills consist of Flexible and Adaptability, Initiative and Self Direction, Social and Cross Cultural Skills, Productivity and Accountability, and lastly, Leadership and Responsibility. Students are taught, throughout the year, age appropriate lessons to build their understanding and application. As the year progresses, expectations have higher measurement standards; therefore, it is a more

difficult area to measure. The formal measurement was taken from semester report card scores. If a student reached proficiency (3) for both semesters, he/she was considered as making growth since expectations from first semester to second semester have higher expectations as the school year progresses. Elementary students are graded as follows - Advanced (4): Student applies and extends key concepts and skills that go beyond what was taught in class. Proficient (3): Student demonstrates and applies a complete understanding of key concepts and skills. Basic (2): Student demonstrates a general understanding, but has an incomplete application of key concepts and skills. Below Basic (1): Student demonstrates a lack of understanding of key concepts and skills. As indicated above, as the year progresses, expectations have higher measurement standards; therefore, it is a more difficult area to measure. Of our in-person student population 93.5% demonstrated growth in College, Career and Community Readiness as measured by our Elementary Life and Career Skills from first semester to second semester. Shapiro Stem Academy's attendance rate is indicated below.
