SECTION III: ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE OF CHARTER SCHOOLS

The Career and College Academy focuses academic instruction on the core disciplines of Mathematics, Science, Social Studies and English/Language Arts for their programs – Competency, 17 credit high school diploma, 24 credit high school diploma, and Senior Skills (GED Option 2). Successful academic achievement leads to graduation with a high school diploma. Students are enrolled in youth apprenticeships, and classes at Gateway Technical College, University of Wisconsin-Whitewater to achieve elective credits to graduation. In the 2020-2021 school year, the school had 60 graduates. Of the graduating class, two students did not graduate by the end of the spring term. The students continued throughout the summer to finish their requirements. All of the two students finished their requirements during the summer session. The graduation percentage, counting the completers is 100% for the 2020-2021 school year.

The Options Virtual Charter School serves students in 4K-12 in a variety of instructional delivery models including completely virtual and blended learning. Students in 4K-8 are evaluated through a portfolio process containing teacher directed assignments and summative evaluations. Students in grades 9-12 are assigned traditional letter grades and must earn a 60% or higher to earn credit for a course. Options Virtual Charter School state report card achievement data for English Language Arts and Mathematics using grades 3-8 Forward Exam and 11th grade ACT results indicate we have a school score of 59/100 which equals or exceeds 67.7% of K-12 Schools in the state. Options Virtual Charter School also received a score of 87.1/100

for On-track to Graduation which equals or exceeds 74.2% of K-12 schools in the state.
