#### SECTION III: ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE OF CHARTER SCHOOLS

The WCEC Career and College Academy focuses on academic instruction in the core disciplines with each student having an individual plan on how they will achieve their career or college aspirations. The school offers multiple pathways to a high school diploma - 24 credit, 17 credit, Competency, and GED Option 2. Successful academic achievement leads to graduation with a high school diploma. The change to the Career and College Academy has significantly impacted enrollment. While the Alternative High School in 2020-21, the school enrolled 70-80 students. Now, as the Career and College Academy, the school enrollment in September of 2022 was 160 students. This has fueled enrollment at all grade levels, but has had the largest impact on the number of students participating in college courses in high school that gives each student the opportunity to earn a credential, technical diploma, or Associate's Degree while working on completing the requirements for a high school diploma. To achieve credit in their core subjects, students are required to meet a level of achievement of 70% or higher in their daily work. At the culmination of the 2021-22 school year, 97% of graduates met this standard.

**The OPtions Virtual Charter School** serves students in 4K-12. Students in 4K-8 are evaluated through a portfolio process containing teacher directed assignments and summative evaluations. Students in grades 9-12 are assigned traditional letter grades and must earn a 60% or higher to earn credit for a course.

OPtions Virtual Charter School state report card received an overall score of 70.1 indicating that the school "Exceeds Expectations". Data for English Language Arts using grades 3-8 Forward Exam and 11th grade ACT results indicate we have 53.6% of students scoring advanced or proficient in English and Language Arts, exceeding the

state average. Options Virtual School also received a score of 89.1 for On-track to graduation, which is the same or higher than 81.1% of K-12 schools in the state.
