Subject: Investment Policies, Objectives and Guidelines

Members of the Legislature:

Pursuant to Section 25.17(14r) of the Wisconsin Statutes, I want to advise you that since our last report on April 3, 2024 there were some revisions to the SWIB Investment Committee (IC) Wisconsin Retirement System (WRS) Investment Guidelines.

At its March 21, 2024 meeting, the Investment Committee approved amendments to the SWIB IC WRS Investment Guidelines, which included:

- Updating approval thresholds for investments in the Private Markets & Funds Alpha (PMFA) division with respect to new managers and follow-on commitments to existing managers;
- Adding that private debt portfolio instruments may be fixed or floating rate;
- Clarifying exposure limit language throughout the PMFA guidelines, including:
 - Incorporating co-investments into exposure limits across the PMFA portfolios;
 - Measuring the venture capital co-investment limit against the aggregate venture capital portfolio; and

- o Updating the single-manager exposure limit for the current return portfolio;
- Adding a venture capital co-investment soft risk parameter; and
- Modifying the soft risk parameters for the beta one fixed income and equity portfolios.

These amendments were reported to the Board of Trustees at its June 12, 2024 meeting.
