2021 SENATE RESOLUTION 2

January 12, 2021 - Introduced by Senators LARSON, AGARD, CARPENTER, ERPENBACH, SMITH, ROYS, BEWLEY, PFAFF, RINGHAND, WIRCH, L. TAYLOR and JOHNSON.

1 **Relating to:** mandatory wearing of masks in state capitol.

2 Whereas, according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention,
3 “COVID-19 spreads mainly from person to person through respiratory droplets”
4 which travel through the air when individuals “cough, sneeze, talk, shout, or sing”;
5 and

6 Whereas, the CDC recommends that “Everyone 2 years of age and older should
7 wear a mask in public settings and when they are around people who do not live in
8 their household”; and

9 Whereas, elected officials should set a clear and unified example for the public
10 by following proper public health recommendations and adhering to the highest
11 levels of safety precautions; and

12 Whereas, wearing masks is a simple and critically important action that can
13 reduce the rate of COVID-19 infections, support our economic recovery efforts,
14 prevent our health system from becoming overwhelmed, and save lives; and
