



2025 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 36

April 29, 2025 - Introduced by Senators PFAFF, BRADLEY, DRAKE, ROYS, SPREITZER, CABRAL-GUEVARA and HESSELBEIN, cosponsored by Representatives BILLINGS, DOYLE, EMERSON, DESMIDT, ARNEY, JOERS, SINICKI, MURSAU, ROE, VINING, KIRSCH, MURPHY, MIRESE, ORTIZ-VELEZ, STUBBS, DITTRICH, MADISON, GOODWIN, BARE, CLANCY, PHELPS, KNODL, SUBECK, PALMERI, WICHGERS, J. Relating to: congratulating the University of Wisconsin–La Crosse women’s gymnastics team on winning the 2025 National Collegiate Gymnastics Association Championship.

Whereas, on March 22, 2025, the UW–La Crosse Eagles women’s gymnastics team posted a score of 194.925 points at the National Collegiate Gymnastics Association Championship hosted by Gustavus Adolphus College, earning the program’s 18th national title and first since 2016; and

Whereas, several UW–La Crosse gymnastics team members earned individual awards and honors, including junior Grace Kehr, who captured the vault championship and an All-America honor in vault and floor exercise; sophomore Raina Christenson, who tied for first on the balance beam and earned an All-America honor in that event; sophomore Claire Robbins, who also tied for first on the balance beam and earned an All-America honor in that event; senior Kyla Dickson, who tied for first on the balance beam and received All-America honors in

balance beam and floor exercise; senior Jessica Taylor, who earned first place in floor exercise and an All-America honor in that event; sophomore Paige Breckwoldt, who earned an All-America honor in vault; sophomore Sarah Best, who earned an All-America honor in uneven parallel bars; and freshman Grace Edwards, who earned an All-America honor in floor exercise; and

Whereas, this national championship victory concludes a superb regular season in which the team finished second in the WIAC/NCGA West Regional Championship and went 5-0 in dual meets; and

Whereas, this victory is the eighteenth national championship for the Eagles and represents the highest score in a national championship meet in the team's history; now, therefore, be it

Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That the members of the Wisconsin Legislature congratulate the University of Wisconsin–La Crosse Women's Gymnastics team on their outstanding achievement and accomplishments.
