**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 171**

May 19, 2025 - Offered by Representative TUSLER.

At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

- 1.** Page 8, line 18: delete “agency, ~~person, data broker, business, or association~~” and substitute “agency or directly to a person, data broker, business, or association”.
- 2.** Page 10, line 1: before “information” insert “personal”.
- 3.** Page 10, line 3: delete the material beginning with “A government” and ending with “available.” on line 7 and substitute “A government agency that provides a record to another government agency under this subd. 2. d. shall, notwithstanding par. (d), provide the receiving government agency all written requests applicable to such records and notice to the judicial officer of the transmission in the manner indicated on the judicial officer’s written request.

Upon receipt of any such written request, the receiving government agency shall be considered to have received the written request pursuant to par. (b) 1. a.”.

4. Page 12, line 22: delete “and (b)”.

5. Page 12, line 23: delete “are” and substitute “is”.

6. Page 13, line 9: delete lines 9 to 15 and substitute:

“**SECTION 21m.** 757.07 (5) (b) of the statutes, as created by 2023 Wisconsin Act 235, is repealed and recreated to read:

757.07 (5) (b) Whenever a judicial officer believes that a government agency has violated the requirements under this section, the judicial officer may bring an action for a writ of mandamus.”.

7. Page 13, line 18: delete the material beginning with “order” and ending with “attorney fees.” on line 20 and substitute “award costs and reasonable attorney fees to the judicial officer. For an action under par. (a), costs and reasonable attorney fees shall be paid by the business, association, data broker, or other person responsible for the violation. For an action under par. (b), costs and reasonable attorney fees shall be paid by the government agency responsible for the violation.”.

8. Page 14, line 5: delete “post,” and substitute “post or”.

9. Page 14, line 6: delete “, or permit inspection and copying under s. 19.35”.
