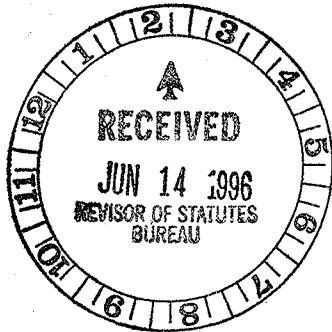

ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES  
BOARD REPEALING AND RECREATING AND CREATING RULES

The Wisconsin Natural Resources Board proposes an order to repeal and recreate NR 10.01(1)(g)l.l. and 10.31(11) and create NR 10.01(1)(g)l.m. relating to migratory game bird hunting.

In this order:

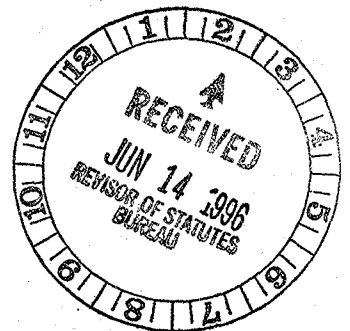
Section 1. Early goose hunt subzone - retitles subzone for season date and bag purposes.

Section 2. Early goose hunt subzone - creates season dates and bag limits for new subzone.

Section 3. Early goose hunt subzone - creates a second early September Canada goose subzone and identifies each subzone.

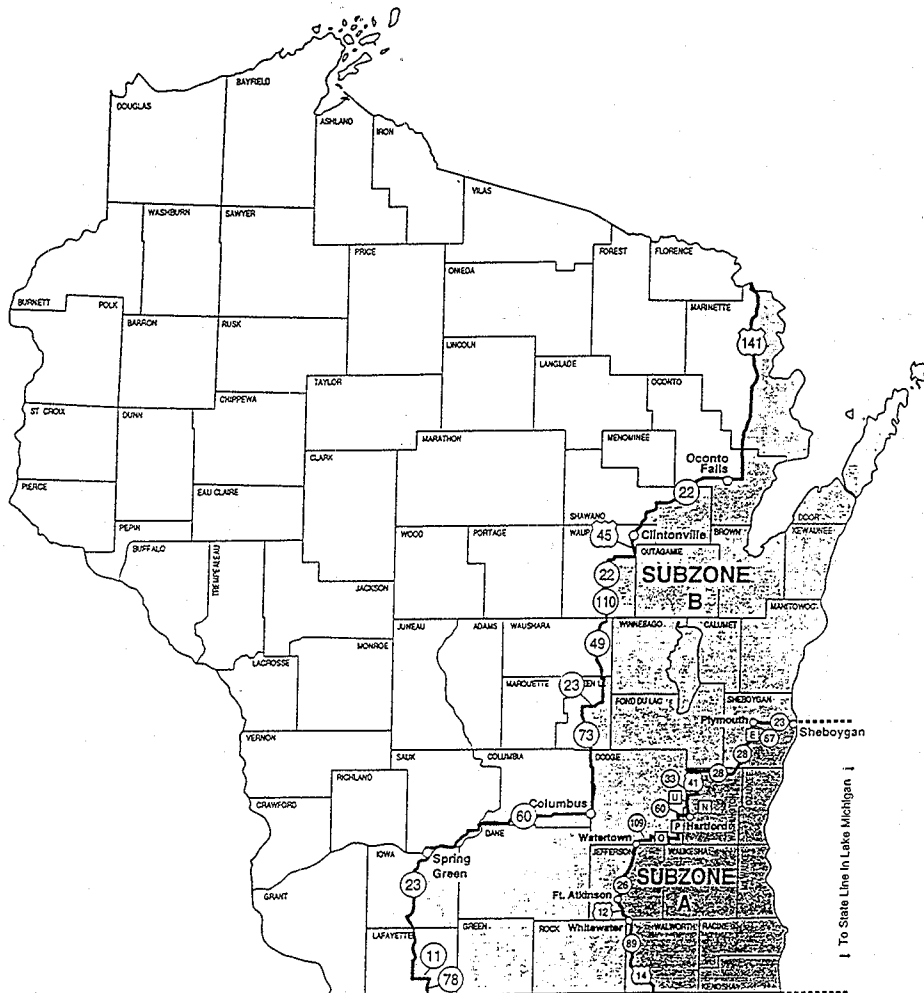

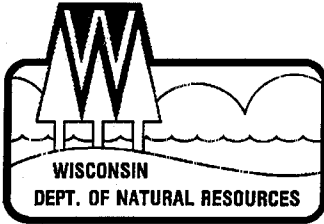

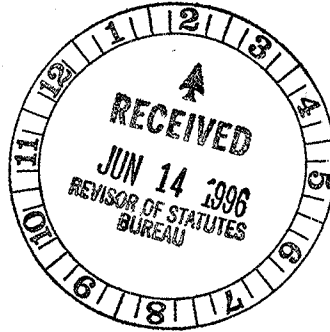
