



ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD  
AMENDING RULES

 permanent order to amend s. NR 20.20(73)(j)4,  
 relating to sport fishing for yellow perch in  
 portions of tributaries to Lake Michigan defined  
 as outlying trout and salmon waters  
 .....

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: ss. 29.014(1), 29.053(2) and 227.11(2)(a), Stats.  
 Statutes interpreted: ss. 29.014(1) and 29.053(2), Stats.

The order affects sport fishing rules on tributaries to Lake Michigan. It modifies the sport fishing rules for yellow perch in portions of inland waters that are tributary streams of Lake Michigan (but not Green Bay). The affected waters will be closed to perch fishing during June and will have a daily bag limit of 5 for the remainder of the year.

SECTION 1. NR 20.20(73)(j)4., as affected by Clearinghouse Rule 98-148, is amended to read:

The rules contained herein shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register, as provided in s. 227.22(2)(intro.), Stats.




