The statement of scope for this rule, SS 095-24 was approved by the Governor on August 8, 2024, published in Register No. 824A3 on August 19, 2024, and approved by the Natural Resources Board on October 2, 2024. This rule was approved by the Governor on July 10, 2025.

### **Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources**

**1. Statute Interpreted:** Section 23.09 (2) (c), Stats., is interpreted as allowing the department to designate fish refuges. Sections 29.014 (1), 29.041 and 29.053 (2), Stats., have been interpreted as authorizing the department to conserve and regulate the fish supply on waters of the state while continuing to provide opportunities for good fishing.

- 2. Statutory Authority: Sections 29.014 (1), 29.041, and 29.053 (2), Stats., authorize these rules.
- **3. Explanation of Agency Authority:** Section 23.09 (2) (c), Stats., provides that the department may designate fish refuges to secure the perpetuation and adequate supply of any species of fish and provide safe retreats in which fish may breed and replenish adjacent fishing waters.

The department is directed under s. 29.014 (1), Stats., to establish and maintain any bag limits and conditions governing the taking of fish that will conserve the fish supply and ensure the citizens of this state continued opportunities for good fishing.

Section 29.041, Stats., provides that the department may regulate fishing on and in all interstate boundary waters and outlying waters.

Section 29.053 (2), Stats., provides that the department may establish conditions governing the taking of fish for the state as a whole, for counties or parts of counties, or for waterbodies or parts of waterbodies. It also allows the department to establish a fishing season on specified bodies of water in certain urban areas to allow fishing only by persons who are under 16 years old or who are disabled, as specified in s. 29.193 (3) (a), (b), or (c), Stats.

- **4. Related Statutes or Rules:** No related statutes or rules apply.
- **5. Plain Language Analysis:** This rule will apply fishing regulations to waters of the state to accomplish management goals. Such management goals include improving the size structure of game fish, increasing the density or abundance of certain fish species, increasing the survival of mature adults, establishing statewide regulations that provide harvest opportunities while protecting fish populations, and aligning regulations with public desires for certain waterbodies. The department utilizes the annual Spring Fish and Wildlife Hearings, held annually statewide, to gain broad public feedback from outdoor recreators on standard fishing regulation change proposals. Specifically, these rules would accomplish the following:

SECTION 1 allows for motor trolling with up to three hooks, baits, or lures in Lincoln, Sawyer, Sheboygan and Waupaca Counties.

SECTION 2 adds a title to the countywide section and opens Waushara and Marquette Counties to the early catch and release trout season.

SECTIONS 3, 9, 18, 19, 23, 26, 27, 29, 31, 36, 37, 39, 40, 42, 43, 58, 64, 68, 69, 71, 74, 78, 84, 92, 93, 104, 113, 119, 124, 129, 134, 135, 136, 138, 139, 152, 153, 158, 165, 166 and 181 establish a catch-and-release hook-and-line fishing season for lake sturgeon from the first Saturday in June through the first Sunday in March on numerous waterbodies around the state where Lake sturgeon surveys conducted by the DNR show stable and/or expanding sturgeon populations.

SECTION 3 applies a no minimum length limit and 14 to 18-inch protected slot size with a daily combined bag limit of 5, except only 1 fish can be over 18 inches for large and smallmouth bass to Crooked Lake, Camelot Lake, Lake Sherwood, and Lake Arrowhead (Adams County).

SECTIONS 4, 88 and 168 apply a 25 to 35-inch protected slot limit and a daily bag limit of 2 northern pike on Crooked Lake (Adams County), Cedar Lake (Manitowoc County); and Wallace Lake (Washington County).

SECTIONS 5, 44, 47, 54, 81, 85, 88, 92, 121, 140, 145, 152, 159, 168, 173 and 177 change the panfish bag limit on a number of water bodies from an experimental regulation to a 10 panfish in aggregate bag. The goals for applying this regulation to these waters are to protect or improve the size structures of multiple panfish species present in the lakes and to simplify regulations, make them more consistent, and more enforceable.

SECTIONS 5, 47, 81, 85, 88 and 170 apply a species-specific daily bag limit of 5 bluegill in conjunction with a daily bag limit of 10 panfish in aggregate allowing for harvest reductions of one species where they are not necessary for all panfish species together. During the panfish regulations experiment, bag limits of 5 for particular panfish species were concluded to most consistently meet objectives for improving the size structure for that species.

SECTIONS 7, 8, 10, 11, 13, 16, 17, 18, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 28, 30, 32, 33, 34, 35, 38, 41, 46, 49, 52, 55, 57, 59, 60, 63, 65, 67, 70, 72, 73, 74, 75, 76, 77, 79, 80, 83, 87, 90, 91, 92, 95, 97, 101, 102, 103, 105, 106, 110, 111, 112, 113, 114, 115, 117, 118, 121, 122, 123, 126, 127, 128, 130, 132, 133, 134, 137, 143, 144, 145, 146, 147, 148, 149, 151, 152, 154, 155, 156, 157, 162, 164, 167, 170, 171, 172, 176, 179, 180, and 181 change the opening date for trout harvest on inland streams, springs, and spring ponds that are classified trout water to the first Saturday of April, instead of the first Saturday in May. This change would extend the harvest season on these waters by approximately 23 to 30 days and increase opportunity for anglers.

SECTIONS 7, 16, 33, 76, 90, 92, 122, 127, 143, 147, 171 and 176 maintain a 3-fish bag, 8-inch size limit for trout on specific waterbodies.

SECTIONS 8, 17, 28, 32, 34, 35, 49, 52, 57, 59, 60, 67, 73, 74, 75, 77, 80, 91, 92, 97, 103, 106, 112, 123, 128, 132, 133, 137, 144, 148, 164, 170, 172 and 181 apply only one statewide county-based regulation of 5 trout in total with no minimum size limit to the state instead of the current 2 county-based regulations (currently 5-fish bag, no minimum size limit and 3-fish bag, 8-inch size limit are the two regs).

SECTIONS 10, 11, 13, 15, 20, 24, 53, 70, 85, 92, 97, 106, 107, 111, 118, 121, 124, 134, 140, 159, 167, 180 and 184 establish a uniform statewide opening day for the inland muskellunge season as the first Saturday in May.

SECTION 12 applies a no minimum length limit for largemouth bass and an 18-inch minimum length and a daily bag limit of 1 smallmouth bass to the Pike Lake Chain (Bayfield County).

SECTIONS 13 and 14 remove the current more liberal size and bag limit for walleye and applies an 18-inch minimum length limit, except fish from 22 to 28 inch may not be kept, with a daily bag limit of 1 for walleye to the Pike Lake Chain (Bayfield County). This is needed to help rehabilitate the walleye fishery on those waters.

SECTION 21 creates a catch and release season for brook trout on portions of the Clam River in Burnett County.

SECTIONS 23, 41, 50, 62, 100, 106, 109 and 134 reduce the panfish bag from 25 to 10 in aggregate on certain waterbodies where concerns have increased regarding the quality and duration of the panfish fishery and recent survey data indicates signs of exploited panfish populations. Recent research has shown that reducing panfish daily bag limits to  $\leq$ 10 fish may noticeably reduce harvest mortality and may improve population size structure.

SECTIONS 32, 59, 65, 130, 155 and 156 change the daily bag limit of 5 trout under 12 inches to daily bag limit of 5 trout but only 1 trout over 12 inches on Gordon Creek (Iowa County), Willow Creek, Camp Creek, Knapp Creek, Mill Creek (Richland County), Elk Creek (Vernon & Richland counties), Big Green River, Borah Creek, Little Grant River, Crooked Creek (Grant County), Mt. Vernon Creek (Dane County).

SECTIONS 41, 113, 114, 117 and 149 apply a regulation of no minimum length except only one over 12 inches may be kept and a 5-trout combined daily bag to all Pierce County trout streams that extend into St. Croix (Kinnickinnic River and tributaries, Rush River and Eau Galle River-also in Dunn County) and Pepin County (Plum Creek), excluding Cady and Pine creeks.

SECTIONS 53, 159 and 161 apply a 25-panfish daily bag limit but only 5 perch can be harvested on Kentuck Lake in Vilas and Forest counties.

SECTIONS 59 and 147 apply a 2-trout bag with a 12-inch minimum length limit and no bait restrictions to the Onion River downstream of CTH E to CTH N (Sheboygan County), and the Platte River (Grant County).

SECTIONS 59 and 67 apply a 5-bag limit, no minimum size on brown and rainbow trout, brook trout must be immediately released regulation to Lee Creek and Martin Creek (Iowa County), Sixmile Branch (Grant and Iowa counties) and Big Spring Branch downstream of Pine Tree Road (Grant County); where the previous regulation was 3 trout over 8 inches.

SECTIONS 61 and 99 implement a 25 to 35-inch protected slot limit and a daily bag limit of 2 northern pike on Lake Puckaway and portions of the Fox, Montello and Grand Rivers (Green Lake and Marquette counties).

SECTION 88 applies a 26-inch minimum length limit and a daily bag limit of 2 northern pike on Silver Lake (Manitowoc County) and applies a 25 to 35-inch protected slot limit and a daily bag limit of 2 northern pike on Cedar Lake (Manitowoc County). It also applies a a special regulation of 10 aggregate bag limit for panfish with no more than 5 yellow perch for Harpt Lake (Manitowoc County).

SECTION 89 applies a 25 panfish daily bag in aggregate but no more than 5 bluegill regulation to Long Lake (Manitowoc County).

SECTION 92 expands the daily bag limit to 5-fish and no minimum length limit for northern pike in Pike Lake (Marathon County).

SECTION 98 adds Unnamed Lake (T30N R23E S21; Marinette County) to the DNR's Urban and Community Fishing Program and applies the associated regulations to this body of water.

SECTION 106 clarifies that Bass Lake and Gilkey Lake are included with Crooked Lake and have a combined bag limit for walleye.

SECTION 107 changes the bass regulations on Crescent and Pelican lakes in Oneida County. This section applies a no minimum length limit with a 5-fish combined daily bag for largemouth and smallmouth bass on Crescent Lake and applies a no minimum length limit and 14 to 18-inch protected slot size with a daily bag limit of 5 (largemouth and smallmouth bass combined), except only 1 fish can be over 18 inches on Pelican Lake.

SECTION 110 applies an 18-inch minimum length limit, except no fish from 22 to 28 inches may be kept, with a daily bag limit of 1 for walleye to George Lake and Crescent Lake in Oneida County.

SECTIONS 125 and 140 changes the northern pike regulation on Wilson Flowage in the Chequamegon-Nicolet National Forest, Price County, and on Nelson Lake, Sawyer County, to a 25 to 35-inch protected slot length limit and a daily bag limit of 5.

SECTIONS 132 and 147 apply the regulation of 5 trout in total (daily bag), brown trout and rainbow trout no minimum length limit, but all brook trout caught shall be immediately released to Grinsell Branch, Hanzel Creek, and unnamed tributary to Melanchton Creek (Richland County) and Nichols Creek (Sheboygan County).

SECTION 136 applies an 18-inch minimum length limit and 3-fish daily bag limit for walleyes to Lake Redstone (Sauk County).

SECTION 142 creates a special regulation for Black Dan Lake, Island Lake, Osprey Lake, Round and Little Round Lake, and Windigo Lake in Sawyer County of a daily bag limit of 25 panfish but no more than 5 crappies.

SECTION 144 applies an 18-inch minimum length limit and 3-fish daily bag for walleye to Sand Lake (Sawyer County).

SECTION 159 changes the bag limit from experimental limits on a number of Vilas County lakes to the base regulation of 25-panfish per day.

SECTIONS 159 and 163 apply a daily combined bag limit of 5 fish and no minimum length limit on largemouth and smallmouth bass to Turtle Lake and Pleasant Lake (Walworth County) and Upper Gresham Lake (Vilas County).

SECTIONS 161 and 175 apply a species-specific daily bag limit of 5 bluegill to the standard panfish bag limit of 25 panfish in aggregate allowing for harvest reductions of one species where they are not necessary for all panfish species together. During the panfish regulations experiment, bag limits of 5 for particular panfish species (not 5 in aggregate) were concluded to most consistently meet objectives for improving the size structure for that species.

SECTION 183 extends the catch-and-release season until July 1 for smallmouth bass in the waters of Green Bay and within 5 miles of the Door County shoreline in Lake Michigan. This also includes the Fox, Oconto and Peshtigo Rivers up to the first dam, but does not include waters within ¼ mile of the town of Washington Island which have different regulations.

SECTION 185 provides for a closed season for shovelnose sturgeon to protect those vulnerable populations during those the spring spawning season.

SECTIONS 186, 187 and 188 creates consistent regulations across the St. Louis River and Western Lake Superior to manage this migratory population of walleye in the same manner and help with enforcement issues. The regulation includes a more protective length regulation in the St. Louis River, while keeping the bag limit and minimum length limit of 15 inches the same. It also reduces the current bag limit in Western Lake Superior (management unit WI-1, Superior to Bark Point), while keeping the length limits the same and creates consistency across both Wisconsin and Minnesota jurisdictions.

### 6. Summary of, and Comparison with, Existing or Proposed Federal Statutes and Regulations:

No federal regulations apply. States retain management authority over the fish and wildlife resources within state boundaries provided that state regulations do not conflict with regulations established in the Federal Register. None of these rule changes violate or conflict with the provisions established in the Federal Code of Regulations.

# 7. If Held, Summary of Comments Received During Preliminary Comment Period and at Public Hearing on the Statement of Scope:

The department was not required to hold a preliminary public hearing on this rule.

## 8. Comparison with Similar Rules in Adjacent States:

Individual state agencies are responsible for managing fisheries within their state boundaries and each jurisdiction has its own decision-making process. Wisconsin's approach to fisheries management and regulations are comparable to that of surrounding states. Additionally, Wisconsin works with the natural resources agencies of neighboring states when proposing rules relating to fishing in shared boundary waters. The St. Louis River regulation changes described in this rule are consistent with the Minnesota side of the river.

# 9. Summary of Factual Data and Analytical Methodologies Used and How Any Related Findings Support the Regulatory Approach Chosen:

With this rule, the department will make changes to certain fish size limits, bag limits, seasons, and other regulations related to fishing in inland, outlying, and boundary waters. Fishing regulations are in place to help meet management goals and objectives for the diverse fish populations in waters of the state. New regulations are proposed when management goals have changed or the department must address a critical need, such as a fish population decline.

The regulation proposals included in this rule are based on biological surveys and analyses conducted by fisheries biologists and input from local stakeholders and the Wisconsin Conservation Congress. Department staff specialists in Fisheries Management, Law Enforcement, and Legal Services review all proposals for justification, enforceability, and completeness.

Based on the management goals for individual waters and species, the department strives to provide:

- consumptive opportunities where anglers can fish for a meal from a self-sustained, slow-growing fish population;
- quality and memorable opportunities where anglers can catch large fish and the density of adult fish in the populations are sustained or increased; and
- trophy opportunities where anglers can catch large trophy-size fish and the survival of older and larger fish is increased.

This rule contains a notable multi-waterbody regulation that establishes a catch-and-release hook-and-line fishing season for lake sturgeon from the first Saturday in June through the first Sunday in March. Recently, the DNR conducted a hooking mortality study to determine if expanding angling opportunities would have negative biological effects on lake sturgeon populations. This study took place on multiple lake sturgeon fisheries throughout the state across a range of water

temperatures. No lake sturgeon mortality was observed during the study. Additionally, the physiological impacts of angling on the test subjects were low. Most hooked sturgeon recovered immediately without impairment upon release. These results suggest that expanding the catch and release opportunities will have little, if any, negative impacts on lake sturgeon populations.

This rule also contains over 120 size and bag limit regulation changes to waters primarily of local interest. The majority of these proposals apply an alternate fisheries management toolbox regulation to specific waters of the state to create consistency in regulation types while maintaining diverse fishing opportunities across the state and responding to public desires for fishing regulation changes. A significant number of them relate to panfish regulations, because changes to panfish bag limits have been largely on hold pending the results of a recent 10-year panfish study of experimental regulations.

Most recreational fishing regulation changes are updated in the administrative code every two years. Forestalling the proposed rule changes would result in less-than-optimal management of fish populations in waters of the state and reduced fishing opportunities for resident and visiting anglers. However, existing regulations would remain in place to provide some level of continued protection of fish resources.

# 10. Analysis and Supporting Documents Used to Determine the Effect on Small Business or in Preparation of an Economic Impact Report:

The department does not expect an economic impact or change directly related to implementing these rule changes (less than \$50,000, minimal to no economic impact). The proposed rule will primarily affect recreational anglers, but will not impose any costs on anglers or fishing-related businesses. Fishing regulations are already in place for waters of the state, and this rule is intended to continue the protection and enhancement of the state's fish resources by adjusting regulations on specific waters where there is a management need. One purpose of the rule is to help maintain the general, beneficial economic impact of fishing throughout Wisconsin. Updated fishing regulations will also help ensure the sustainability of fish populations for the continued benefit of anglers and the fishing economy into the future.

The department prepared an economic impact analysis and solicited public input to determine if any individuals, businesses, local governments, or other entities expect to be adversely affected economically by the rule. The department received no comments on the economic impacts of implementing or complying with this rule.

### 11. Effect on Small Business (final regulatory flexibility analysis):

The proposed rule would not impose any reporting requirements on small businesses, nor are any design or operational standards contained in the rule. The rule would not allow for the potential to establish a reduced fine for small businesses, nor would it establish "alternative enforcement mechanisms" for "minor violations" of administrative rules made by small businesses.

#### **RULE TEXT**

## **SECTION 1. NR 20.15 (4) is amended to read:**
