

AN ACT

To provide for levying a tax on Jefferson school district in the town of Grafton for building a school house, and on district number one, in the town of Elkhorn, for the same purpose.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SECTION 1. That the trustees of Jefferson school district, Trustees of Jefferson school district authorized to levy tax. in the town of Grafton, Washington county, are hereby authorized to levy a tax upon all the taxable property in said school district not exceeding six hundred dollars, for the purpose of building a school house and appurtenances and the purchase of a site for the same: and that said tax be collected, and accounted for, in the same manner as other school district taxes. *Provided*, that the legal voters of said district Proviso. vote to raise said tax in the manner now provided by law.

SEC. 2. That the trustees of school district number one, Trustees of school district number one in the town of Elkhorn, Walworth county, are hereby authorized to levy a tax upon all the taxable property in said district, not exceeding six hundred dollars, for the purpose of building a school house therein, and for the purchase of a site therefor, and of suitable appurtenances: *Provided* the legal voters of said district shall vote to raise said tax in the Proviso. manner now provided by law.

SEC. 3. The said last mentioned tax shall be collected and accounted for, in the same manner as other school district taxes.
