

AN ACT

To divorce Stewart McKee from his wife Eliza McKee.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SECTION 1. That the marriage contract heretofore existing between Stewart McKee and his wife Eliza McKee be, and the same is hereby dissolved, and the parties to the said contract are by virtue of this act restored to all the rights and privileges of unmarried persons.

AN ACT

Providing compensation to the agent of the territory for locating the university lands.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SECTION 1. That the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars be, and the same is hereby appropriated to N. F. Hyer, the agent

heretofore appointed, to complete the location of the university lands, in full compensation for his services by virtue of his said appointment, one-half thereof to be paid down, and the balance when the work shall have been finally completed and approved by the secretary of the treasury ; and the auditor of the territory is hereby required to issue his warrants on the treasury, in accordance with this act.
