Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Although difficult to determine the number of veterans that would request this service, WDVA estimates that between four (4) and seven (7) members may participate in the program. WDVA has estimated that it would cost approximately \$5,000 per request. This cost would be approximately \$3,000 for the medication and \$2,000 for other services (psychiatric costs, administrative costs and additional costs for the second doctor's opinion).
