Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP) issues more than 1,000 bulk milk weigher and sampler licenses every two years. The license fee is \$60. This bill will allow an unknown number of bulk milk weigher and sampler licensees to obtain their licenses in other states and use that license in Wisconsin. Bulk milk weigher and samplers licensed in other states would be inspected in other states, thus reducing inspection costs for DATCP. DATCP also anticipates a reduction in revenue since an unknown number of licensees from other states would not be required to purchase a license in Wisconsin.
