Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Among its many provisions, AB-1013 provides additional funding to the Wisconsin Technical College System for state aid to Wisconsin's 16 technical colleges. The bill increases the state aid appropriation s.20.292(1)(d) by an additional \$28,000,000 in funding for FY2022-23. State aid is distributed to the 16 technical college districts based on a statutory formula.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications
