## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

The bill would increase the statutory allocation for Children and Family Aids under ch. 48.563(2), Wis. Stats., by \$23,400,000 in SFY 2023 and provides \$23,400,000 GPR in s. 20.437(1)(b) for the distribution of Children and Family Aids to counties for SFY 2023.

The bill would increase the statutory allocation for Community Youth and Family Aids under ch. 48.526(7)(a), Wis. Stats., by \$10,400,000 in CY2022 and by \$10,400,000 in the first half of CY2023. The bill provides \$20,800,000 GPR in s. 20.437(7)(b) for the distribution of Community Youth and Family Aids to counties for SFY 2023.

The fiscal effect for DCF is an increase of \$44,200,000 GPR in SFY 2023 for distribution to the counties.
