<b>Description</b> crisis training for law enforcement officers					

**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill requires that biennially, each law enforcement officer must complete four hours of crisis management training as part of the annual 24 hour training requirement for recertification or 600 hour preparatory training requirement for certification.

This bill does not require additional hours of training for certification or recertification of law enforcement officers, however there may be an indeterminate incremental increase in costs for local law enforcement agencies and training academies to acquire training materials or programs and train existing instructor staff on crisis management. The Department of Justice employs sworn law enforcement officers in the Division of Criminal Investigation and may incur an indeterminate one-time increase in costs for implementing new training which can be absorbed within existing resources.

The Law Enforcement Standards Board and the Bureau of Training and Standards in the Division of Law Enforcement Services will incur an indeterminate increase in costs to update, communicate and enforce revised training standards, and assist local law enforcement agencies to comply with the revised requirement.
