Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill requires law enforcement agencies to adopt a written policy regarding drug and alcohol testing following an officer-involved incident. The policy must require an officer involved in a qualifying incident to submit to drug and alcohol testing as soon as practicable following the incident and that the testing screen for, at minimum, alcohol, amphetamines, cannabis/cannabinoids, opiates, cocaine, phencyclidine and anabolic steroids.

Local law enforcement agencies may incur additional costs if this testing exceeds current practice. Based on existing contracts, costs for this testing may be under \$100 per employee, however the number of officers involved in qualifying incidents is unknown.
