Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This fiscal estimate is submitted by the Director of the State Prosecutors Office on behalf of Agency 475 – District Attorneys. This fiscal estimate is responsive only to the fiscal and resource effect of the proposed legislation on the District Attorney program.

This bill proposes various changes to procedures related to the supervised community release of sexually violent persons. This bill modifies the definition of "youth center" to include private property on which recreational, vocational, academic, or social services activities are regularly provided for persons under 18. The bill requires the law enforcement agencies to, at least 10 working days before the person is placed, provide written notice of the placement to all private residences within 1,500 feet of the approved residence. Under the bill, DHS must reimburse local governments for the costs incurred for providing such notice.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

There are no anticipated long-range fiscal impacts to DA offices resulting from this bill.
