## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill creates a grant program under the Department of Public Instruction to award grants to school districts for energy efficiency projects. Due to the maintenance of effort requirements of the federal Consolidated Appropriations Act for the federal American Rescue Plan Act, it would also provide additional funding to the UW System.

## **Long-Range Fiscal Implications**

The UW System's general program operations appropriation would be increased by \$970,00 in 2022-23. The funding would be used for strategic initiatives identified by the President and Board of Regents.
