Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill requires DNR to waive any daily fee for admission to a state park on April 22 of each year in commemoration of Earth Day.

State Fiscal Effect

A. Cost

The Department estimates one-time costs of \$1,000 to promote the admission fee waiver.

B. Revenue

Assuming \$300,000 in daily admission revenues for the month of April, based upon 2017-19 data, the Department estimates the bill would reduce daily admission revenue by \$10,000/year (\$300,000 divided by 30 days in April = \$10,000). The revenue loss could be higher to the extent that April 22 falls on a Saturday or Sunday.
