### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill requires the Department to award up to \$100,000 in each fiscal year in the 2021-23 fiscal biennium in grants to local governments or American Indian tribes or bands that have declared wild parsnip to be a noxious weed for projects on public or private land to map, control, eradicate, monitor, and minimize the spread of wild parsnip.

In addition, the bill appropriates \$50,000 in each fiscal year in the 2021-23 fiscal biennium to the Bureau of Natural Heritage Conservation (NHC) to administer the grant program.

#### State Fiscal Effect

- 1. Grant Administration--NHC will absorb the cost to administer the grants with the funding provided in the bill.
- 2. Grants expenditures will increase by an estimated \$100,000/year, which coincides with the funding prescribed in the bill.

#### Local Fiscal Effect

Revenue and costs for local units of government will increase to the extent that they successfully compete for a grant.

Local units of government could incur costs above and beyond the grant since successful parsnip eradication requires ongoing effort.
