### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The IT work required to account for the changes to the charging statutes would cost approximately \$23,300 and require approximately 3 months to implement.

Under state statute, no forfeiture collected from traffic violations is distributed to DOT. See 59.25(3)(j) and 66.0114(3)(b)

Local governments may see an increase in revenue from the forfeiture collected from traffic citations. The exact number of citations that would be issued is unclear. The State of Washington enacted similar legislation in 2017 and saw a total of 6,475 citations issued in the first six months of implementation, which if holding constant would mean a total of 12,950 citations for the full year. Wisconsin has approximately 78.6% the number of licensed drivers that Washington has, which would mean a total of approximately 10,179 citations if the same proportion of citations to drivers is issued in Wisconsin.

The legislation amends statute so that the maximum forfeiture that may be assessed for first offense is \$100. However, it is possible that the amount would be set to a lower amount, such as what is assessed currently (\$20) for using a hand-held wireless communication device in a construction zone. For convictions of citations issued under state statute, 50% of the forfeiture (base deposit) would go to the county in which the citation is issued.

If there were to be 10,179 first offense convictions with the range of forfeitures between \$20 and \$100 the result for county governments would be \$101,790 - \$508,950. It is likely that this range would fluctuate as time passes, as increased awareness of the penalty will likely lead to fewer violations over time but will also create second and subsequent offenders.

#### Long-Range Fiscal Implications

A small long-term increase in ticket revenue for counties and local governments.
