### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill contains many provisions impacting several state agencies. This fiscal estimate focuses only on the provisions that impact the Department of Public Instruction (DPI).

The bill creates a new GPR sum-certain appropriation and requires DPI to annually distribute funding to The Literacy Lab, a Virginia nonstock corporation, for the purpose of providing evidence-based literacy interventions to pupils in prekindergarten to 3rd grade in this state. The appropriation amount is \$1,500,000 in FY22 and FY23.

Local Impact: no impact. The bill requires DPI to distribute the appropriated funds to the Literacy Lab. As such, no school districts or schools would receive funding from the proposed appropriation.

State Impact: \$1,500,000 GPR (new expenditure) annually.

## **Long-Range Fiscal Implications**

The bill does not sunset the appropriation after FY23, so the additional \$1,500,000 expenditure is assumed to continue annually after FY23.
