## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Senate Bill 443 creates the Transgender Equality Task Force. The task force is required to study the legal and societal barriers to the equality for transgender, intersex, nonbinary, and gender nonconforming individuals in Wisconsin and provide recommendations to the governor and legislature on how to ensure the equality and improve the lives of those individuals.

The legislation requires the task force to provide recommendations to address any existing barriers in multiple areas including, but not limited to higher education. The measure also requires representatives from multiple different government entities including, but not limited to one representative from The Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS).

## Long-Range Fiscal Implications

The WTCS may absorb the administrative costs related to having one representative participate on the task force.
