Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under SB-605, the Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS) Board must develop procedures for determining Wisconsin residency at WTCS colleges for an active duty member of the armed forces who has been relocated from Wisconsin and is stationed on active duty in another state. In addition, the relocated service member's spouse and dependents, are considered residents of this state during this period of relocation if they demonstrate under the procedures, that they are residents of Wisconsin during the relocation period. If such a demonstration is made, these dependents continue to be considered residents of Wisconsin after the relocation period has ended.

The WTCS Board has no way of knowing how many service members in Wisconsin, along with their spouses and dependents, would be relocated from active duty in Wisconsin to active duty in another state, and therefore eligible to receive Wisconsin residency.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications
