Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill requires the Department to modify administrative rules relating to the hunting of wild turkeys, to combine hunting zones and seasons, and to modify youth hunting restrictions.

Fiscal Effect

A. Revenue

The department may need to reduce the number of spring turkey harvest authorizations under the proposed spring turkey season structure to limit hunter densities. This would lead to fewer harvest authorizations issued via the drawing and the leftover harvest authorizations available for purchase, which would ultimately impact the amount of revenue available for wild turkey restoration and habitat projects.

The overall revenue impact is indeterminate since it is unknown how many spring turkey harvest authorizations will be made available under the proposed structure. Determinations will need to be made on how quotas will be set and harvest authorizations distributed.

B. Cost

The department estimates that it would incur one-time costs of \$26,000 to implement the provisions of the bill. These costs are itemized as follows:

- 1. Rule Writing and Hearings: 40 hours = \$3,000 for salary and fringe benefits
- 2. Go Wild System Modifications: 40 hours x \$50/hr. = \$2,000 for salary and fringe benefits for a business analyst
- 3. Updating informational materials, including web pages, the spring turkey application tutorial, and agent resources: 40 hours x \$50/hr. = \$2,000 for salary and fringe benefits for a policy advisor
- 4. Training customer service staff on new spring turkey season, turkey management zone structure and application
- a. 20 hours training development x \$50/hr. salary & fringe for a policy advisor = \$1,000
- b. 1 hour of customer service staff training x 100 staff x 27.50/hr. salary & fringe for a customer service representative rate = 2.750
- 5. Updating turkey hunting regulations: \$1,000
- 6. Updating department web pages: \$1,000
- 7. Communication and outreach: \$10,000
- 8. Staff time for analysis of harvest recommendations: \$3,000
