Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The proposed legislation requires the Department of Health Services to reimburse ambulance service providers for a set of two epinephrine auto-injectors or a set of two draw-up epinephrine kits for each ambulance operating in the state. The bill also provides additional funding for the Department of Public Instruction, the University of Wisconsin system and the Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS).

This fiscal estimate for the proposed legislation addresses the section specifically pertaining to the WTCS.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

The proposed legislation would increase the WTCS general state aid in FY 2021-22 and 2022-23 by \$4,500, which would be distributed amongst all 16 technical colleges through the system funding formula.
