**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill will have no annual fiscal effect on the Department of Transportation. It will create no new annual expenditures or revenues.

This bill expands the class of individuals eligible for the veteran identifier on their driver's license. The department has no data on how many individuals will be made eligible by this bill. The department assumes many of those individuals who desire the indicator already apply for the identifier and do so at the time of initial issuance or renewal. The department therefor assumes no change to the total processing time spent on veteran identifier applications or to the number of applications for the identifier. The department can train staff on this new change in ordinary training efforts.

**Long-Range Fiscal Implications**
