## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill requires the Department of Children and Families to provide scholarships to adopted children and their biological siblings to attend programs together to build sibling connections. Due to the maintenance of effort requirements of the federal Consolidated Appropriations Act and the federal American Rescue Plan Act, it would also provide additional funding to the UW System.

## **Long-Range Fiscal Implications**

The UW System's general program operations appropriation would be increased by \$10,000 in 2021-22 and 2022-23. The funding would be used for strategic initiatives identified by the President and Board of Regents.
