Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill increases the amount that each county and municipality annually receives as a county and municipal aid payment. Currently, a county or municipality receives a payment equal to what it received in 2012, and the bill increases that amount by 2 percent in 2022 and an additional 2 percent beginning in 2023.

Under the bill, the county and municipal aid payment will increase by approximately \$15,061,600 in 2022 for payment FY 2023 and \$30,424,300 in 2023 for payment in FY 2024. The fiscal estimate is based on a current law payment of \$753,075,700. Counties and municipalities would receive an increase proportionate to the amount they currently receive under current law. Based on the total increase for 2022 and 2023, the median increase for towns is \$1,064, \$4,754 for villages, \$24,882 for cities, and \$37,209 for counties.

The department cannot absorb one-time administrative costs of \$29,500 for computer programming changes and ongoing costs of \$2,000.
