Executive Order Number 103
Relating to a Special Session of the Legislature on
Unemployment Insurance Modernization

I, TONY EVERS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the Laws of the State, specifically Article IV, Section 11 and Article V, Section 4 of the Wisconsin Constitution, hereby require the convening of a special session of the Legislature at the Capitol in the City of Madison, to commence at 12:00 pm on Tuesday, January 19, 2021, solely to consider and act upon LRB-1312/1 and LRB-1430/1, relating to transactions with the Department of Workforce Development under the unemployment insurance law, funding for unemployment

insurance modernizations efforts, granting rule-making authority, and making an appropriation.
