CLEARINGHOUSE RULE 22-019

Comments

[NOTE: All citations to “Manual” in the comments below are to the Administrative Rules Procedures Manual, prepared by the Legislative Council Staff and the Legislative Reference Bureau, dated November 2020.]

2. Form, Style and Placement in Administrative Code

a. In SECTION 2 of the proposed rule, “trained individual” should be fully underscored in s. DHS 77.03 (3), as renumbered.

b. In SECTIONS 7, 10, and 20 of the proposed rule, underscored material should follow stricken text.

c. Is the intent of the extensive renumbering in SECTIONS 10 to 17 to provide an order of priority for the reimbursement of activities as described in SECTION 12? If so, it is not clear from the text of SECTION 12 that such priority exists, comparing s. DHS 77.04 (3) (a) (intro.) to s. DHS 77.04 (3) (b) (intro.). If not, the department should consider whether all such renumbering is necessary. [See s. 1.10 (3), Manual.]

d. In SECTION 32, treatment of punctuation at the end of the second sentence of s. DHS 77.09 (1) (intro.) should be reviewed. Currently, one period is stricken, and another is indicated with both underscored and stricken text.

5. Clarity, Grammar, Punctuation and Use of Plain Language

a. In SECTION 8 of the proposed rule, insert “a” after the words “pays for” and before the words “communication access services provider”.

b. In SECTIONS 34 and 35, capitalization of the first word following “Note:” should be consistent.
