

shall not be construed as to prevent any other person or persons from erecting bridges over said stream any where in the same vicinity.

SECTION 4. That the privileges hereby granted shall continue and be in force for the term of ten years and no longer.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "an act to incorporate the Fox river hydraulic company."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the council and house of representatives of the territory of Wisconsin,* That the capital stock of said company may at any time be increased to five hundred thousand dollars, at any meeting of the stockholders called for that purpose—twenty days notice thereof to be previously given: *provided,* that it shall be optional for any stockholder to take or not any additional shares of stock. And if he shall neglect or refuse within ten days after the vote of increase, to take the shares to which he would be entitled in such increased stock, the same shall be sold at public auction by the directors for the benefit of the company.

Stock may be increased to \$500,000.

SECTION 2. The directors shall have full power to transact all business of the company; to audit all accounts to give and receive all evidence of debt, as they may deem advisable for the interest of the company; all accounts to be certified by one of their body under such name and style as they shall direct. And said directors shall make half yearly dividends of so much of the profits as they may deem advisable for the interest of said company.

Powers of directors.

SECTION 3. So much of the act to which this is amendatory as contravenes any of the provisions of this act is hereby repealed.
