An act to amend an act to provide for levying and collecting state revenue.

Chap 125

*THE People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The first section of the act to provide for the levying and collecting state revenue, approved August 1st, 1848, is hereby amended so as not to allow any thing to be received by the state treasurer in payment of the revenue of the state, but gold and silver, after the passage of this act.

Revenue to be paid in gold and silver.

SEC. 2. This act shall not be so construed as to prevent the treasurer of the state from receiving evidence of state indebtedness, which may be in the hands of the county treasurer on the date of the passage of this act.

To receive &c.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect immediately after its passage, and the secretary of state shall cause the same to be published in some newspaper printed in Madison, as soon after its passage as can be done in the due course of publication of any paper so published at Madson.

An act to organize a school district, in the town of San Prairie, in Dane county.

Chap 126

*THE People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. That sections one, two, three, ten, eleven, twelve and the north half of sections thirteen, fourteen and fifteen, in town eight range eleven east, are hereby formed into and constitute a separate school district, and may be numbered to correspond with the other districts of said town.
