

An act to audit the claims of Racine county.

Chap 69.

*THE People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :*

Racine co.

SECTION 1. The state treasurer shall give a receipt to the treasurer of the county of Racine, for the sum of one thousand one hundred and sixty-seven dollars and eighty-three cents, in full for the following claims owned by said county, to wit :

*THE People of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. The treasurer of the town of Belgium, in the county of Washington, is hereby authorized to demand and re-

ceive from the treasurer of the town of Port Washington, in Washington county, or from the treasurer of the county of Washington, the taxes collected by the collector of the town of Port Washington within and for said town, for the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-eight.

Chap 72. An act to provide for the publication of an act to amend the act entitled "an act to establish the time of holding circuit courts."

*THE People of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

To publish act.

It shall be the duty of the secretary of state to cause to be published "an act to amend the act entitled an act to establish the time of holding circuit courts," approved March 6th, 1849, in one or more of the newspapers printed at the seat of government of this state, and from the date of said publication, the said act shall take effect.

Chap 73. An act to extend the boundaries of the county of Marquette.

*THE People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

Boundaries of Marquette.

SECTION 1. All that portion of country lying and being within the boundaries of townships numbered fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen, eighteen, nineteen, and twenty, north of ranges numbered eight, nine, ten, eleven, twelve and thirteen east, shall hereafter compose and constitute the county of Marquette.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
