

An act to prescribe certain duties of the Board of Public Works, and to amend an act entitled "an act to provide for the improvement of the Fox and Wisconsin rivers, and connecting the same by a canal," approved August 8, 1848. Chap 74.

THE People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. That the board of public works shall proceed in the improvement of the Fox and Wisconsin rivers and the connection thereof by a canal, in the manner by them recommended in the report to the legislature, that is to say: the said board shall first provide for the construction of the Portage canal, the improvement of the Neenah or Fox river above lake Winnebago, the improvement of Rapide Croche, and the improvement at Desperes: and the said board shall be and hereby are limited in their expenditure and contracts for carrying on the said work for the year A. D. 1849, to a sum not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars. To improve &c.

SEC. 2. The board of public works are hereby authorized to commence suits before any justice of the peace, or in any court of the state having jurisdiction, against any person or persons trespassing upon the lands of the canal grants; and all of the laws of this state upon the subject of trespasses upon lands are hereby declared to be in force against trespassers upon the lands granted by congress to aid in the improvement of the Fox and Wisconsin rivers. To prevent trespasses.

SEC. 3. All suits commenced by the said board against trespassers upon said lands shall be commenced in the name of "the board of public works of the state of Wisconsin," and the attorney general shall be required to prosecute all suits so commenced, except such as may be commenced before a justice of the peace or a county court. Style of suits.

An act to change the boundary of the towns of Jefferson and Koshkonong, in the county of Jefferson. Chap 75.

THE People of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Sections twenty-five, twenty-six, twenty-seven, twenty-eight, twenty-nine, thirty, thirty-one, thirty-two, thirty-three, thirty-four, thirty-five, and thirty-six, being and lying in the south part of the town of Jefferson, adjoining the town of Koshkonong, and in the county of Jefferson, are hereby set off from the said town of Jefferson, and annexed to the said town of Koshkonong.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the first Tuesday of April next.

Chap 76. An act to amend the act entitled "an act to establish the times of holding circuit courts."

THE People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

Second circuit.

SECTION 1. The courts of the second judicial circuit, in the state of Wisconsin, shall be holden as follows :

In the county of Dane, on the first Monday in April and second Monday in October of each year :

In the county of Jefferson, on the fourth Monday in April and fourth Monday in October of each year :

In the county of Waukesha, on the second Monday in March and second Monday in November of each year :

In the county of Milwaukee, on the first Monday in February, the first Monday in May, and the first Monday in September of each year.

Third circuit.

SEC. 2. The courts of the third judicial circuit, of the state of Wisconsin, shall be holden as follows :

In the county of Portage, on the second Monday in March and the last Monday in August of each year :

In the county of Sauk, on the fourth Monday in March and the second Monday in September of each year :

In the county of Marquette, on the first Monday in April and fourth Monday in September of each year :

In the county of Dodge, on the second Monday in April and the first Monday in October of each year :

In the county of Washington, on the fourth Monday in April and the fourth Monday in October of each year :

In the county of Columbia, on the third Monday in May and the first Monday in October of each year.

Fourth circuit.

SEC. 3. The circuit courts for the county of Sheboygan, in the fourth judicial circuit, shall be holden on the second Monday in March and the third Monday in September of each year :

In the county of Manitowoc, on the first Thursday after the third Monday in March and on the first Thursday after the fourth Monday in September of each year.

Process.

SEC. 4. All process returnable at the several terms of the second, third and fourth circuit courts, as appointed to be held by the act of which this is amendatory, excepting in the counties of Brown, Winnebago, and Fond du Lac, shall be returned at the several terms of the said courts, as fixed by this act.

SEC. 5. It shall be lawful for the judge of any circuit in this
