Chap. 14.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated to James P. Greeves, twenty dollars and seventy-five cents, for medical attendance on Nolan, Conrad, Myers and Bonham, up to December twelfth, eighteen hundred and fifty, to be paid out of any funds in the State Treasury not otherwise appropriated.

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated to Hatch & Patterson, ten dollars and eighty-two cents, for medicines for state prisoners, up to October twenty-seventh, eighteen hundred and fifty, to be paid out of any funds in the State Treasury not otherwise appropriated.

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated to J. H. Brown seventeen dollars for medical attendance on Joseph A. Palmer, a state prisoner up to August 15th, 1849, to be paid out of any funds in the State Treasury not otherwise appropriated.
