

An Act to appropriate to Alexander Mitchell a certain sum of money.

Chap. 160.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to Alexander Mitchell to be paid on or after the twentieth day of June next, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, one thousand dollars principal and thirty-five dollars interest in full payment for principal and interest on Wisconsin, Milwaukee and Rock River Canal Loan number fifty-two.

SEC. 2. Upon payment of the above mentioned bond, it together with the accompanying coupons shall be surrendered to the State Treasurer and by him cancelled.

The People of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to Alexander Mitchell the sum of seventy dollars in full payment for interest on Wisconsin, Milwaukee and Rock River Canal Loan number fifty-two, from the twentieth day of December, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine, to December twentieth, one thousand eight hundred and fifty, upon the surrender of the coupons attached to the same, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.

Chap. 162

The People of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. That the board of Supervisors of the several towns, and the board of Aldermen of any incorporated city and the board of Trustees of any incorporated village within this State, may at any regular or special meeting of the board,
