Chap 161

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The name of Mary Ann Reed is hereby changed to Mary Ann Mills.

SEC. 2. The said Mary Ann Reed is hereby constituted the heir at law of Harmon Mills.

An Act to appropriate to Robert Bonham the sum therein named.

Chap 162

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly do enact as follows :

SECTION 1- That there is hereby appropriated to Robert Bonham the sum of three hundred and sixty-five dollars for guarding the state prisoners from January 1st, 1851 to January 1st, 1852, to be paid out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated.

An Act to amend an act to authorize plank and turnpike road companies to borrow money upon the stock of said companies.

Chap 163

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. Any plank road or turnpike road company, incorporated by or under any law of the state of Wisconsin, is hereby authorized and empowered to borrow money upon its bonds, or in such other manner as the board of directors thereof may deem expedient, and to execute a

mortgage of all its stock, property, real and personal, franchises and tolls, to secure the payment thereof. If bonds shall be issued by any such company to raise money, such bonds may be sold or disposed of for such sums and on such terms as the board of directors thereof shall deem best for the interest of the company.

SEC. 2. If any such mortgage, executed by any plank road or turnpike road company shall be foreclosed, or the mortgagee therein shall enter upon the premises mortgaged by reason of any failure of such company to pay the principal sum of money secured to be paid thereby, or the interest thereon, the purchaser or mortgagee, after such entry, may exercise all the rights, powers, and franchises conferred by law upon said company, in the same manner in which the company might lawfully exercise and enjoy the same.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect immediately upon and after its passage.

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An Act to provide for the payment of interest on warrants issued to contractors on the Fox and Wisconsin River Improvement.

Chap 164

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

To pay interest

SECTION 1. That the treasurer of the state land office be and is hereby authorized to pay interest at the rate of twelve per cent. per annum on all such warrants as have been or may hereafter be issued in conformity to a resolution of the board of public works, adopted the ninth day of May, A. D. 1851; also, on all warrants issued to Nelson McNeil and Thomas Reynolds, contractors on the Portage canal and locks at Fort Winnebago.

Notice to be given.

SEC. 2. Whenever there shall be sufficient funds in the treasury for the redemption of such outstanding warrants, it shall be the duty of the treasurer to give public notice in some newspaper published at Oshkosh, that the said warrants will be redeemed upon presentation, and the inter-
