

An Act to amend section 2 of chapter 133 of the Revised Statutes.

Chap 289

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. Section two of chapter one hundred and thirty-three of the revised statutes, is hereby so amended as to read as follows, to wit: such killing, when perpetrated from a premeditated design to effect the death of the person killed, or of any human being, shall be murder in the first degree, and the person who shall be convicted of the same shall suffer the punishment of death, or of imprisonment for life, as the jury in such case shall determine.

Chap 290

SECTION 1. It shall be lawful for said company, their agents, officers, engineers, contractors, and servants at any time to take from any land adjoining said road, gravel, stone, earth, timber, and other material, for the purpose of constructing or repairing said road, subject to the payment of compensation as provided in said act.
