Chap 451

An Act to appropriate to A. F. Spofford the sum of money therein named.

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to A. F. Spofford, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of thirty dollars, in full for chair cushions furnished for the capitol, up to February second, 1852.

Chap 452

An Act to appropriate to William H. Howard the sum therein named.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to William H. Howard the sum of eighty dollars, to be paid out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, in full for services and expenses by him incurred in executing the requisition issued by the governor of this state, on the governor of Indiana, for the arrest and delivery of Leander Randall, a fugitive from justice.
