

Chap. 48. An Act to appropriate to William S. Hascall, assignee of Charles R. Dakin, a certain sum of money therein named.

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SEC. 1. There is hereby appropriated to William S. Hascall, assignee of Charles R. Dakin, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of two hundred and twenty-three dollars and fifteen cents, being in full of the account of Dominick Casey, sheriff of Waukesha county, for boarding William White, J. B. Galloup, and William Flannegan, state prisoners, to November 10th, 1851.
