

board of supervisors," where the words "Clerk of the county" occurs.

Societies to file certificates, &c. SEC. 2. All religious societies, organized under the provisions of this chapter, that may have filed their certificates of election of trustees, and church or society name, with the clerk of the circuit court, or register of deeds, shall as soon as may be, after the passage of this act, cause such certificate or a transcript thereof to be filed with and recorded by the clerk of the board of supervisors, of the proper county, and upon complying with this act, shall be deemed legally organized.

Clerks to obtain books. SEC. 3. The several clerks of the board of supervisors in this state, not yet supplied with suitable books for recording the certificates aforesaid, shall immediately procure such books at the expense of the respective counties.

Chap. 89.

An Act concerning Probate Courts.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Probate courts may renew licenses, heretofore or hereafter granted by such counties, to executors, administrators or guardians, authorizing the sale of lands of any deceased person or ward, and such licenses may be so renewed from time, and for such length of time, as such court shall deem proper.

SEC. 2. This act shall be printed immediately after its passage, and when so printed shall be in force.

Chap. 90.

An Act in relation to appeals from the decision of Town Superintendents.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Appeals.

SECTION 1. That whenever an appeal shall have been made from the decision of any town superintendent to the state superintendent of schools, and the decision appealed from, is reversed, if any money shall have been apportioned and paid to any school district, upon such decision of the town superintendent, previous to the final decision of the state superintendent; and if the state superintendent shall have also decided that such
